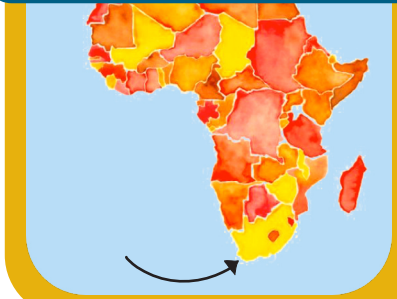

Ocean View formed in 1968 after the South African government forcefully removed coloured people from certain areas, leaving many with bitter resentment still today. The area is known for high unemployment, drugs, crime, prostitution, school drop-outs and gang fights. Insecure and fearful, most of the youth have parents in prison, on drugs, are alcoholics and/or criminals and gangsters. Because of the challenging and disruptive behaviors in such families, they are typically not being reached nor felt welcomed by the local churches. The youth struggle with trust issues from unstable homes, where they experience much trauma from sexual and physical abuse. Unfortunately, many who have met God backslide because of the difficult challenges they face at home and in their community.

In 2016, Stefano and Doris Lindsay from Switzerland founded HopeTown, a youth center in one of Ocean View's gang areas. The Lindsays have since been joined by two other missionary couples also with All Nations: Lukas and Celina Müller, and Johannes and Maria Schilling. Together, they work with locals who have come to faith through HopeTown, giving them purpose and job-readiness for their next step in life. The team's investment is long-term, with a heart to raise up and disciple local leaders and see transformation in the community. Their goal is to offer holistic development through education, skills training and mentoring. Through a variety of programs, youth grow in social skills, work ethics, character, team work, quality control and self confidence. Creating a safe, loving community is the foundation for everything they do.
